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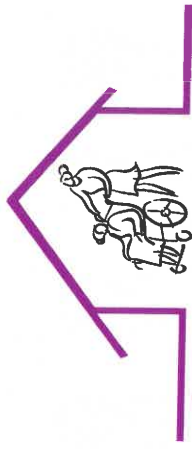

About Our Agency

Comprehensive Home Health Care & Hospice, your neighborhood health partner, was founded in 2013 with the idea that health care is at its best when people who deliver it are from the community. Comprehensive is not a chain or a corporate giant-far from it! We believe in caring for our Hospice Clients and their families during the most difficult and emotional stage of their lives. We also ensure that our clients are included in health care decisions. The word "hospice" brings up different images to many people, death and dying being predominant. But to those who have experienced hospice, they visualize a concept less tied to modern health systems and more to that old philosophy of caring that goes back to the middle ages when travellers, weary from their journey, stopped alone the road and were tended to by monks at special places called hospices. At Comprehensive, we embrace the philosophy of caring inspired by these monks and carried through to the twentieth century in Ireland and England where the modern hospice movement began.

What Is Hospice?

Hospice is a very special way of caring for people with terminal illness and their loved ones. The focus is on care and not cure. Hospice uses a team approach consisting of people with different skills, working together to plan and coordinate care. Comprehensive Hospice Care has a mission to provide compassionate, quality end-of-life and grief support to patient and families.



Personalized Services

Comprehensive Hospice Care is provided through an inter disciplinary, medically directed team. Our team approaches the care for a dying person through physicians, nurses, home health aides, social workers, volunteers, spiritual care coordinators and therapists.

Hospice Nurse: They make regular scheduled visits to the patient providing expert pain management and symptom control techniques. The nurse keeps the primary physician informed of the patient's condition throughout the time they are under hospice care.

Home Health Aides: HHA provide assistance with the personal care to our patients.

Medical Social Worker(MSW): They evaluate the need for assistance, practical and financial concerns emotional support, counseling and bereavement.

They also access the need for volunteers and other support services needed by the family to help facilitate communications between family and other community agencies.

Spiritual Care: We provide spiritual care support to a patient and their family plus serves as a liaison between them and their religious community. Our chaplain often assists in arrangements of memorial and funeral services.

Therapy: If clinically required we provide Physical, Occupational, and Speech therapy to our hospice patients.

Admission And Financial Arrangements

Comprehensive services are available to anyone who has made the decision to seek palliative (comfort) care. Eligibility for hospice services is determined by the patient's physician, or our medical director, who certifies that the patient has a life-limiting illness with a prognosis of six months or less.

Comprehensive accepts Medi-Cal, Medicare and private insurances. There are little if any out of

pocket costs. Medications, medical supplies and equipment related to the hospice diagnosis are provided depending on the coverage. Co-payment and services not covered by insurance will be billed to the patient.

Goals Of Comprehensive

We are there when you need us. When families are facing serious illness, Comprehensive helps guide the patient and their loved ones through the entire end-of-life experience. Our care is focused on providing holistic treatment (physical, social, emotional and spiritual) for the patient and their families as a whole during this complex phase of the human journey. Our goal is to ensure that the patient is comfortable and free from pain. Hospice care enables the patient and the family to spend precious time together and to make informed decisions that affect the quality of life. The Comprehensive team of skilled professionals and the medical director works with the patient's physician to create an individualized care plan that meets the unique needs of each patient and family. Our staff members make regular home visits and a nurse is available 24 hours a day to answer questions or help with a crisis. By promoting independence, comfort, dignity and compassion, Comprehensive helps patients and their loved ones find meaning in each day.
